

**PERBANDINGAN PROMOSI KESEHATAN MENGGUNAKAN MEDIA
POWERPOINT PRESTANTION DENGAN KEBERSIHAN
GIGI DAN MULUT SISWA KELAS VII DI SMP
MIFTAHUL HUDA AL-HUSNA
KOTA TASIKMALAYA**

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ABSTRACT

Latar Belakang: Masalah kebersihan gigi dan mulut masih menjadi tantangan kesehatan, terutama pada anak usia sekolah. WHO melaporkan karies gigi anak usia sekolah 60–90%. Data SKI 2023 Masalah kebersihan gigi dan mulut masih tinggi pada anak usia sekolah. Di Indonesia, 20 provinsi memiliki prevalensi di atas rata-rata nasional. Jawa Barat memiliki masalah kesehatan gigi dan mulut anak sebesar 58%. Kota Tasikmalaya mencapai 46,39%, lebih tinggi dari rata-rata provinsi 45,66%. Sekolah menjadi tempat strategis promosi kesehatan. Media edukasi visual seperti *PowerPoint Presentation* diharapkan menjadi solusi efektif meningkatkan pemahaman dan bentuk perilaku positif menjaga kebersihan gigi dan mulut sejak dini. **Tujuan:** Mengetahui perbandingan promosi kesehatan menggunakan media *PowerPoint Presentation* dengan kebersihan gigi dan mulut siswa kelas VII SMP Miftahul Huda Al-Husna Kota Tasikmalaya. **Metode:** Penelitian ini bersifat deskriptif kuantitatif dengan pendekatan pre-test dan post-test. Sampel berjumlah 35 siswa dengan teknik *total sampling*. Data diperoleh melalui pemeriksaan kebersihan gigi dan mulut menggunakan *index OHI-S*, serta penyuluhan dengan media *PowerPoint Presentation*. **Hasil:** Sebelum penyuluhan, 31,4% siswa dalam kategori buruk, 48,6% cukup, dan 20% baik. Setelah penyuluhan, kategori baik meningkat menjadi 25,7%, cukup menjadi 62,9%, dan buruk menurun menjadi 11,4%. **Kesimpulan:** Promosi kesehatan dengan media *PowerPoint Presentation* efektif meningkatkan pengetahuan dan kebersihan gigi serta mulut siswa. Media ini layak digunakan sebagai metode edukasi yang menarik dan interaktif di sekolah.

HYGIENE OF GRADE VII STUDENTS IN JUNIOR
HIGH SCHOOL MIFTAHUL HUDA AL-HUSNA
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ABSTRACT

Background: Oral health issues remain a significant health challenge, particularly among school-aged children. The World Health Organization (WHO) reports that 60–90% of school-aged children suffer from dental caries. Data from the 2023 SKI survey indicates that oral health issues remain high among school-aged children. In Indonesia, 20 provinces have prevalence rates above the national average. West Java has a dental and oral health problem among children of 58%. The city of Tasikmalaya reaches 46.39%, higher than the provincial average of 45.66%. Schools are strategic locations for health promotion. Visual educational media such as PowerPoint Presentations are expected to be an effective solution to enhance understanding and foster positive behaviors in maintaining dental and oral hygiene from an early age. **Objective:** To determine the effect of health promotion using PowerPoint presentations on the oral hygiene of seventh-grade students at Miftahul Huda Al-Husna Junior High School in Tasikmalaya City. **Method:** This study is a quantitative descriptive study using a pre-test and post-test approach. The sample consisted of 35 students using total sampling technique. Data were collected through oral hygiene examinations using the OHI-S index and health education using PowerPoint Presentations. Results: Before the education session, 31.4% of students were in the poor category, 48.6% in the adequate category, and 20% in the good category. After the education, the good category increased to 25.7%, adequate to 62.9%, and poor decreased to 11.4%. **Conclusion:** Health promotion using PowerPoint presentations is effective in improving students' knowledge and oral hygiene. This medium is suitable for use as an engaging and interactive educational method in schools.
